Potential Research Topics

- B. <u>Under HLP, the following are scaling-up:</u>
 - 1. Linking of Holding Tax Increases to conducting of Open Budget Processes.
 - 2. Union Coordination Committee Meetings for UPs to ensure improved quality of services.
 - 3. Pay-for-use Arsenic Screening as the lowest rung of the arsenic mitigation ladder.
 - UP led promotion of the sanitary protection of hand pumps.
 - 5. Mohila Forum for enhancing UP women member voice in the upazila parishad?

1. Linking Holding Tax to Open Budgets

Research Questions:

- What is the carrot & stick for people to pay tax?
- Do the biggest payers of holding tax also have the greatest voice in open budget processes?
- Do open budgets & increased holding tax collection lead to improved service delivery?
- Does open budgets & increased holding tax collection lead to increased citizen satisfaction?
- Does increased holding tax collections lead to an increase / decrease in other own source revenues?

2. Union Coordination Committee Meetings

Research Questions:

- What are the vital ingredients of a UCCM?
- Is UCCM burdening or empowering for UPs?
- Does UCCM lead to improved service delivery?
- Does UCCM lead to increased citizen satisfaction?
- Is UCCM sustainable?
- Is UCCM changing the role of UP to coordinate others in preference to provision by self?

3. Arsenic Screening & Well Switching?

Research Questions:

- Under pay-for-use arsenic screening conditions are people really switching?
- What is the density of arsenic contamination under which well switching appears to be feasible?
- What is the maximum/ minimum / average distances that people travel when switching drinking source?
- How often should arsenic testing be conducted?
- What are the means for verifying the quality of tests?
- Is it possible to apply this to agricultural sources?
- ?

Cross-cutting HLP Questions

- Why are UPs replicating these good practices?
- Does 'appreciative inquiry' assist in prioritizing inclusion?
- Are these practices resistant to shocks? (i.e. political / social / environmental crisis)
- Is the replication of these practices through HLP leading to improved local governance?
- Are these practices leading to changed policies / relations with the central government?

Open Questions

- Time line? < 6 months
- UP Selection? control / intervention
- Tools? community score cards, quantitative & qualitative surveys

Potential Research Topics

- A. Partner identified research (useful to HLP)
 - Optimum committees at the UP level?
 - Relations between Parishad & Chairman & Secretary & Standing Committees?
 - What are the expert capabilities of the poor?
 - What is the difference between AI & HLP?
